PHASE 2: NEW LEARNING  PHASE 3:	Share the performance indicators and introduce the lesson.  Write this question on the board; "The Impact of Climate Change on Our Planet"  Brainstorm learners to explain the basic concept of climate change and its primary cause.  Divide the class into small groups and have each group discuss one aspect of climate change, such as rising sea levels, extreme weather patterns, or impact on biodiversity. Each group should prepare a short presentation on their findings.  Hand out copies of the informative text on "The Impact of Climate Change on Our Planet". Have learners read the text, either individually or as a class.  Initiate a class discussion on the topic, encouraging learners to share their thoughts and feelings about the issue.  Ask learners to write an essay on how they can contribute to reducing climate change in their daily lives.  Assessment Learners in groups write a Biography on a Historical Figure.
