PHASE I: STARTER	Display a common proverb or saying in English (or another relevant source language) and its equivalent in the target Ghanaian language. Ask learners, "How do the meanings compare? Are there any					
PHASE 2: NEW LEARNING	Ask learners, "How do the meanings compare? Are there any differences in cultural connotations?" Share the performance indicators and introduce the lesson. Translate texts of about one hundred words from source to a target language. Read and discuss the translated text. Provide learners with short passages in the Ghanaian language that contain idiomatic expressions or cultural references. In groups, learners discuss and decode the meanings of these passages, focusing on context and cultural significance. Provide pairs of learners with sentences in the source language (e.g., English) and ask them to translate them to the target Ghanaian language. Similarly, give them sentences in the Ghanaian language to translate to English. After translating, pairs compare their translations with another pair to discuss any differences and challenges faced. As a class, discuss the importance of cultural context in			,
