PHASE I: STARTER	Invite a resource person, such as a representative from the Social Security and National Insurance Trust (SSNIT) or a pension expert, to talk about social security in Ghana. They can provide an overview of social security systems, including the Three Tier Pension Scheme.						
PHASE 2: NEW LEARNING	Explain that the Three Tier Pension Scheme is a system in Ghana that consists of three tiers, each providing different benefits to workers. Discuss Tier I of the scheme, which is a mandatory basic pension scheme managed by SSNIT. Explain that Tier I benefits are based on a worker's average monthly salary and contributions made throughout their working years. Describe Tier 2 as a mandatory occupational pension scheme, where contributions are made by workers and their employers to a privately managed pension fund.						

	Explain that Tier 2 benefits are additional to Tier I benefits and provide a higher level of retirement income. Introduce Tier 3 as a voluntary provident fund or personal pension scheme, where individuals can make additional contributions for retirement savings. Discuss the flexibility and additional benefits that Tier 3 offers, such as investment options and tax advantages. Assessment I.
